Employ critical and creative thinking and independent judgment as versatile and innovative theatre practitioners;

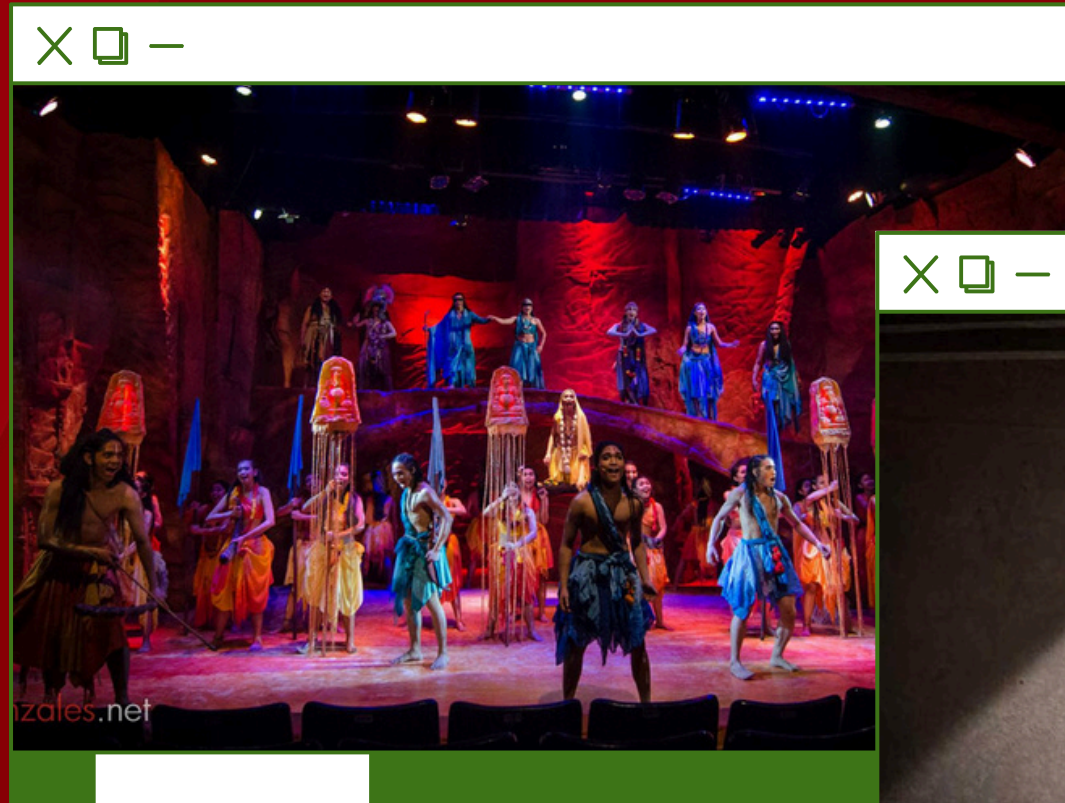

Interested students must have obtained an average of 85 or better in Senior High school or a general weighted average of 2.25 or better for college students not qualified for transfer.

- 3 Recent 2x2 Picture
 - Taken within the last three months; file must not exceed 10MB
- 4 Portfolio of Creative Work in Performance, Directing, Playwriting, Dramaturgy, Design (Costume, Set, Props, Sounds, Lights, Video, and/or Make-up), Management (Stage Management and Production Management), and/or Technical Direction); Awards/Recognitions; and Training/Workshops
 - Your portfolio should reflect the information written in your APPLICATION FORM. The files (in total) must not exceed 25MB.

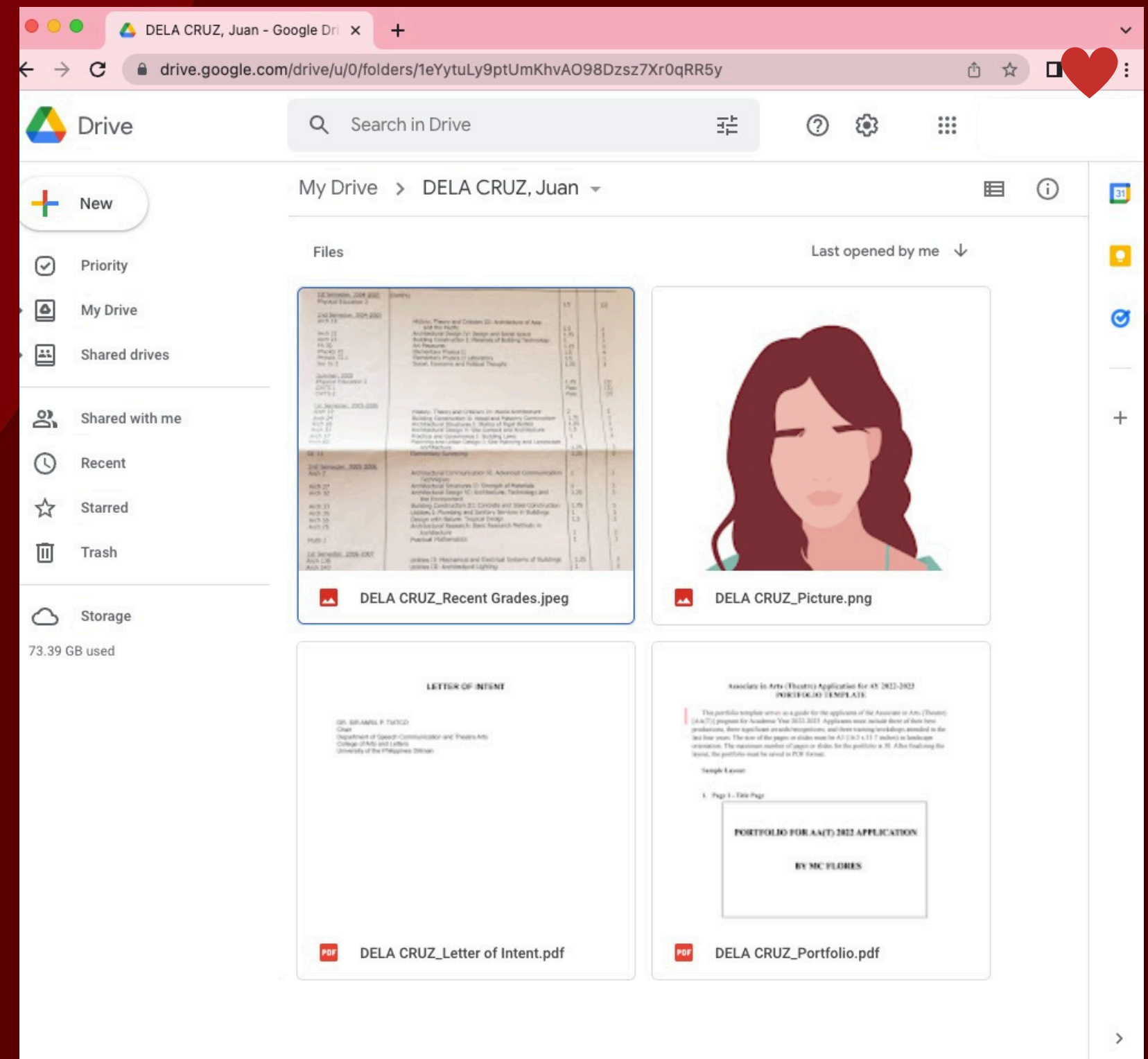

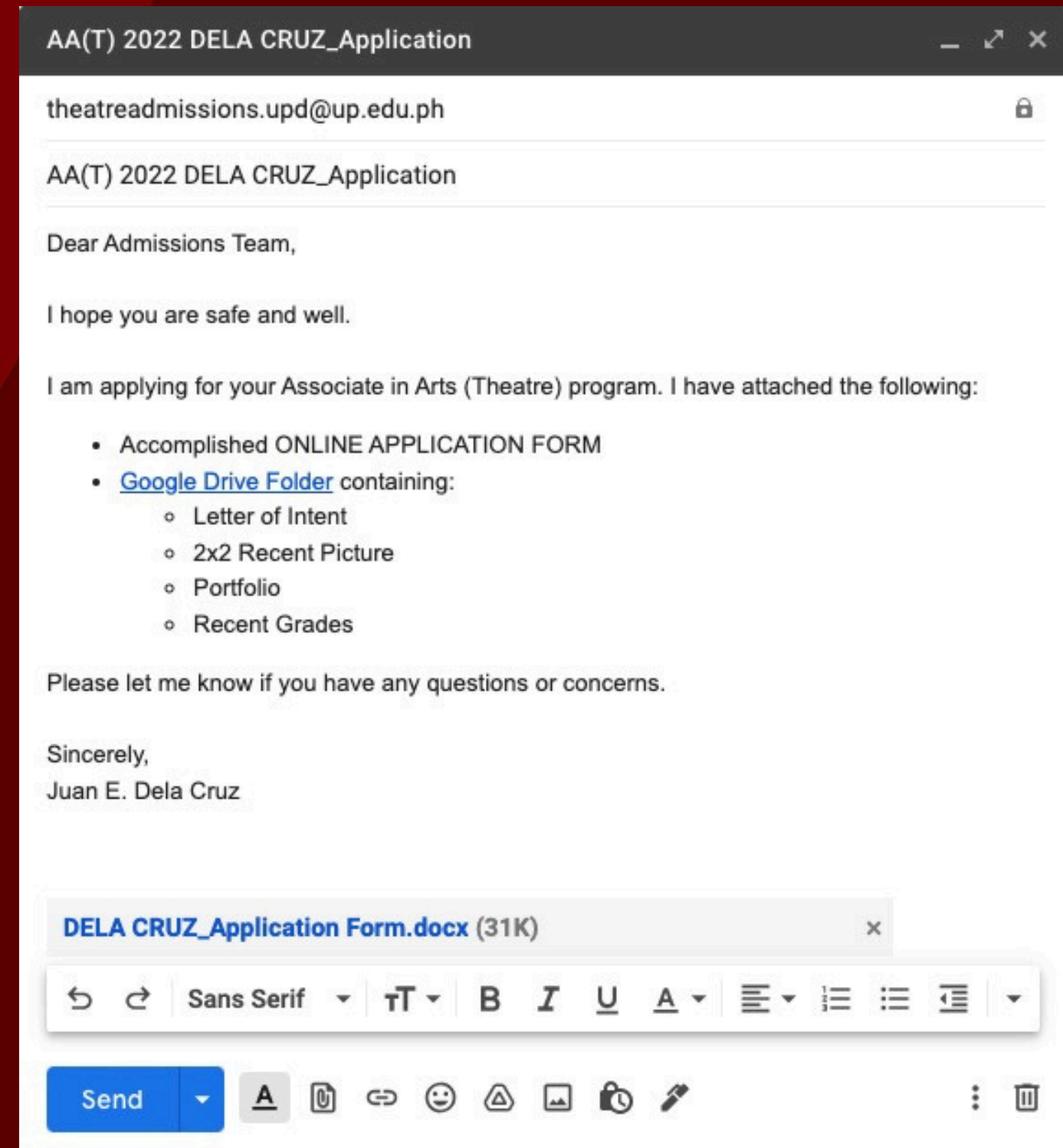
